*Equipment Inspection will be available on Saturday at 8am and Noon for those unable to check-in on Friday. Every attempt should be made to go through equipment inspection on Friday to avoid potential shooting delays.

Eligibility Criteria: A resident of BC must be a member of BC Archery in order to compete in a BC Archery event; a participant who is not a resident of BC must be a registrant of Archery Canada, and must register in a Guest category (see the [BC Archery Rules of Shooting](#))

This event follows [BC Archery Rules of Shooting](#) (which include [Archery Canada Rules](#) (book 2 & book 3)).

Target sizes & scoring:

- U15 Recurve, U15 Barebow and all U13 & U10 categories shoot on a 60cm single spot target.
- All others have a choice of 40cm single spot or 40cm Vertical 3-spot
- All compound participants score inner-10, regardless of age or target size

Dress Code WILL be enforced (Rule AC-20, Book 3).

- Denim Jeans ARE allowed
- Fleece pants / sweat pants are NOT allowed
- Camouflage clothing is NOT allowed (includes hats & footwear)
 - Camo equipment IS allowed (bows, quivers, etc)

Guest medals:

Per the [BC Archery Rules of Shooting](#), there are 2 age classes ("Adult" 18+, and "Youth" 17&younger) and 3 equipment divisions (Compound, Recurve, Barebow). "Guest" medals are awarded to only the first place in each Guest category. Guests are not eligible to be awarded BC Archery Provincial Championship medals.
